ADMISSION CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Quality of Previous Undergraduate and Graduate Work

The minimum requirements necessary for admission to Alvernia University's Master of Science in Nursing program will include an official transcript indicating that the applicant has earned a baccalaureate degree in nursing from a NLNAC or CCNE accredited program at a college or university. A grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for all previous undergraduate and graduate work is normally required for full acceptance. Also, the completion of a undergraduate statistics course and undergraduate research course with a grade of "C" or better is required. A minimum of one year recent relevant practice in nursing is required.

Three Reference Forms

MSN applicants must obtain references using specific forms supplied with the admission packet. The strength of three references from persons competent to judge the applicant's probable success in graduate school will be evaluated. References are preferred from professional nurses with graduate degrees, but can also come from former professors, employers or supervisors. All forms must be placed in envelopes with a signature across the seal and forwarded to the Graduate and Continuing Studies Division at Alvernia University.

Scores on Nationally Standardized Examinations

Applicants must submit scores from examinations such as the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or Miller Analogies Test (MAT) within the past five years. Scores will be used to evaluate the applicant's potential for meeting the demands of coursework at the graduate level. The GRE or MAT will be waived with a grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale and all other admission criteria is satisfactory. This requirement will also be waived for Alvernia alumni, and other students who have earned a bachelor degree five years or more prior to submitting an application.

Applicant's Essay

Applicants must submit a two-page entrance essay. Also note that applicants must follow specific guidelines for both the content and the format of the entrance essay. Guidelines are available from the program coordinator if not included in the application packet.

Personal Interview

After all the required application materials have been received, each applicant will be contacted to arrange for a personal interview. The interview will be conducted by the MSN program coordinator/faculty or a designated representative.

Résumé

Applicants are required to submit a current résumé outlining their professional, educational, and volunteer experiences.

Proof of Valid Registered Nurse License

Applicants must submit a photocopy of their current RN License.

Special Consideration of Applicant's Potential

Alvernia will weigh the evidence submitted by each applicant to assess the candidate's strengths and academic potential. Special consideration will be given to applicants who will enrich the diversity of Alvernia's community. Applicants to the MSN Program will be admitted as described below:

Full Graduate Status: Students admitted to full graduate status must have completed all admission requirements. Students may opt for full time or part time enrollment.

Non-Degree Status: Students may enroll in graduate courses to earn graduate credit for professional certifications or professional development activities in their chosen field. These students must have earned a baccalaureate or other advanced degree from an accredited college or university. Other students may be admitted with non-degree status with the approval of the Dean of the Graduate Programs.

Retention, Completion, and Degree Requirements

Students who receive a letter of acceptance must respond to a written offer of admission that specifies the date of entrance into the MSN Program. This admission letter will serve as a permit-to-register for courses. In most cases, students will be offered admission for a five-year period.

Progress toward completing the graduate degree will be evaluated by each student's advisor on a regular basis. Students with full graduate status must achieve and thereafter maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher to be retained in the program. Students will not be allowed to participate in capstone activities unless they have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher. Academic records of all graduate students will be reviewed at the end of each semester. Students should schedule two meetings with their advisor each year.
