All first and second year undergraduate students who are enrolled full-time, are under 21 years of age, and who have completed 59 or fewer academic credits are required to live in University housing. All students requesting an exemption to this requirement must complete an Off-Campus Housing Petition. Alvernia University's student residences are designed to complement the pursuit of full-time undergraduate studies. For this reason, students who are under the age of 17 and over the age of 30 are not normally eligible for University housing. Petitions for exceptions to this policy will be considered on an individual basis by the Vice President for University Life.
