



### Harrisburg Area Community College | Alvernia University Dual Admissions Intent to Enroll Form

Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC) and Alvernia University (Alvernia) have established a Dual Admissions Transfer Agreement (Agreement). Through this Agreement, students will be guaranteed admission into a specified baccalaureate degree program at Alvernia provided they meet the requirements of the Agreement while enrolled at HACC. Upon admission to HACC, students enrolled in the Dual Admissions program will have access to take courses and utilize the facilities of both institutions and have access to coordinated academic advising between HACC and Alvernia.

Under this Agreement, HACC students will be guaranteed admission at Alvernia for the specified programs on the condition that they:

- 1. Show proof of high school graduation/completion at the time of applying to Alvernia;
- 2. Submit a Dual Admissions Intent form before completion of no more than 45 college level credits from all colleges/universities attended;
- 3. Graduate from HACC with an appropriate Associate in Arts (A.A.), Associate in Science (A.S.), Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) Degree, or Associate in General Studies (A.G.S.) Degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for Accelerated Baccalaureate and Online Programs (through Adult Education Admissions) and 2.5 for Traditional/Residential Baccalaureate Programs. (Please see below for a list of approved degree/majors included in this Agreement);
- 4. Complete Alvernia's admissions application ideally once 45 credits have been earned at HACC, or at least three months prior to the start of the semester in which they plan to begin their studies at Alvernia and satisfy all other regular Alvernia admissions requirements;
- 5. Not attend another institution of higher education between the time they graduate from HACC and enroll at Alvernia;
- 6. Enroll at Alvernia within one year of HACC graduation.

Students who have previously matriculated to Alvernia are not eligible for Dual Admissions to Alvernia but are encouraged to apply as a transfer or re-entry student to Alvernia. Students who matriculate to Alvernia from HACC will be encourage to send Alvernia transcripts back to HACC as part of the reverse transfer process.

There is no obligation on the part of the Dual Admissions HACC student if they decide not to transfer to Alvernia.

Once students submit their Dual Admissions Intent Form, they are strongly encouraged to meet with an Alvernia Transfer Admissions Representative and/or a HACC Academic Advisor, to develop a course taking strategy to maximize course transferability.

HACC graduates entering Alvernia under the terms of this Agreement go through the normal Alvernia transfer admissions process and therefore must meet all applicable Alvernia requirements and deadlines

pertaining to application for admission, orientation, registration, and payment of tuition and fees. They will abide by the policies and procedures, and any revisions thereof that apply to all Alvernia students.
