

How to access the Student Health Portal

1. Go to the Alvernia University Student Health Portal website, <https://alvernia.studenthealthportal.com> OR you can locate it from the logins page from www.alvernia.edu.
2. Enter your username and password, this username/ password will be the same as your Alvernia computer login/ email login (You must access your Alvernia email prior to using the Student Health Portal as your temporary password must be changed first)
3. Click “My forms” in the center of the task bar to access your incomplete medical forms
4. Click “Messages” to check your messages regularly

How to upload a picture to the Student Health Portal

1. Login to the Student Health portal using the above steps
2. Click the document upload tab at the top of the page or select document upload from the menu on a mobile device
3. Click the drop down selection to choose the type of document you are uploading to the portal
4. Browse your personal images, then select the appropriate image or use the camera icon to take a photo of the document from your mobile device
5. Click save

Please review the following health requirements and complete each requirement to avoid registration and/or move-in delays.

(Note: The login for Alvernia’s Student Health Portal is the same as your Alvernia network username/ID and password.)

- ☐ Complete the Alvernia Immunization form on the Student Health Portal, meet all vaccine requirements and upload your immunization record.
 - 3 Hepatitis B Vaccines (positive titer is acceptable)
 - 1 Meningitis vaccine at or after age 16 (Commuter students 21+ years are exempt from this requirement.)
 - 2 MMR vaccines, 1st vaccine on or after your 1st birthday (positive titers are acceptable)
 - 1 Tdap booster after the age of 10.
 - 2 Varicella vaccines or a documented date of chicken pox illness (Nursing, OT, AT, DPT, DNP, PA: documentation of 2 vaccines or a positive titer are required)
- ☐ Upload a copy of your insurance card to the Student Health Portal
- ☐ Complete the Alvernia Tuberculosis Risk Questionnaire on the Student Health Portal and/or provide proof of appropriate tuberculosis testing if indicated
- ☐ Nursing, OT, AT, DPT, DNP, PA students are required to submit a current physical exam, COVID 19 vaccine, and annual flu vaccine prior to participating in field experience. This is not required for first year students not participating in field experiences yet.
